

GPNA Board Meeting November 15, 2010

Present: Judy, Steve, Paul, Marcella, Helena, Tom, Nate, Tomy, Tandy and Bruce

Marcella said 20 people were at the Bingo that morning and a profit of \$99.30 was made.

Helena gave the membership report with 190 residential members and 29 businesses.

Officer Dean Sturgeon said there were 3 burglaries in the neighborhood: 2- businesses and 1 home. And 6 theft from autos. Again he instructed everyone what to do to minimize the thefts from auto. Put all packages in the trunk or out of sight and to take GPS units out of the vehicle so they cannot be seen.

He then asked if we could donate any funds to help Shop with a Cop program at Isaac Shelby School. Bruce made the motion that \$100 be given to this cause. Second by Nate. Motion passed.

Tom gave our Financial report:

Tandy gave an update on the Trolley Circle. She noted that MSD was very interested in taking on the project with a rain garden in the center of the circle. Hopefully this will be started in the Spring of 2011. MSD will be invited to our next meeting to discuss this project with us.

Steve said the Earthwell energy audit suggested we do redo our He also noted that we can apply for a grant to get this project funded. It will be using stimulus dollars.

It was discussed if we should get involved with the Highland Connection, which at times in the past we have sent a representative to their meetings. Nothing decided at this time.

An update was given on the mural at Hope Mills. Aaron and Shawna will be doing this project. The dollars are in place and it is on a timeline.

We will be checking with our insurance company to see if we need a rider of the art work outside of GPNA building.

At our next meeting we will be discussing our grant money and also our holiday donation to the churches in the area.

We discussed maybe only having Quarterly pot luck dinners after then Board meeting. More discussion will follow.
